SUBJECT: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA SUSPENDING SECTIONS 9.36.220 AND 9.36.230 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO LIMITATIONS ON HOURS OF OPERATION OF AMPLIFIED SOUND AND NOISE SOURCES FOR PERMITTED EVENTS AT VICTORY PARK FOR SPECIFIED HOURS ON SUNDAY, APRIL 23, 2000.

TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA SUSPENDING SECTIONS 9.36.220 AND 9.36.230 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO LIMITATIONS ON HOURS OF OPERATION OF AMPLIFIED SOUND AND NOISE SOURCES FOR PERMITTED EVENTS AT VICTORY PARK FOR SPECIFIED HOURS ON SUNDAY, APRIL 23, 2000.

PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE:

This proposed ordinance is to suspend the Noise Ordinance for permitted events at Victory Park on specified times on April 23, 2000, specifically, the proposed Easter Sunrise Service to be held by Calvary Chapel of Pasadena, as to general noise and amplified sound. The enactment of this proposed ordinance is needed for the event to take place.

This event was approved by the City Council at its meeting held February 28, 2000.

REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED:

The Noise Ordinance was enacted by ordinance and can only be suspended by an ordinance of the City Council.


FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

Any City costs that may be incurred (i.e., sound meter reading, park clean up, etc.) are to be paid by Calvary Chapel of Pasadena.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT:

The Environmental Administrator has determined that the proposed suspension of the noise ordinance necessary to hold the Easter Sunday Service is categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines Section 15323, Normal Operations of Facilities for Public Gatherings.



The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 9.36.220 and 9.36.230 of the Pasadena Municipal Code are hereby suspended from the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. on April 23, 2000, for events at Victory Park for which the City has issued a Special Event permit.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause this ordinance to be published in full text.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication.


