ORDINANCE NO.

AN UNCODIFIED ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA GRANTING
NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISES FOR POLICE TOWING TO THREE
APPLICANTS.

WHEREAS, on January 12, 1998, the City Council of the City of Pasadena considered applications for a non-exclusive police towing franchise and adopted Resolution No. 7579, after determining that said applications appeared to comply with Chapter 10.46 of the Pasadena Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, said Resolution was duly published on January 16, 1998, and;

WHEREAS, a duly-noticed public hearing pursuant to said Resolution was held on January 26, 1998, on each application; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing each application, and after public hearing, it was determined that specific applicants comply with Chapter 10.46 of the Pasadena Municipal Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, the People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Chapter 10.46 of the Pasadena Municipal Code, a non-exclusive police towing franchise

("Franchise") for a term of one year from the effective date of this ordinance is granted to:

S.N. WARD & SON, INC.

The Franchise shall not become effective before the effective date of this ordinance and unless and until a written franchise agreement has been signed with the City and unless and until all the requirements set forth in Chapter 10.46 of the Pasadena Municipal Code have been satisfied, including but not limited to evidence of compliance with the insurance and indemnification requirements of said chapter in a form acceptable to the City.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to Chapter 10.46 of the Pasadena Municipal Code, a non-exclusive police towing franchise ("Franchise") for a term of one year from the effective date of this ordinance is granted to:

PASADENA, CALIFORNIA

The Franchise shall not become effective before the effective date of this ordinance and unless and until a written franchise agreement has been signed with the City and unless and until all the requirements set forth in Chapter 10.46 of the Pasadena Municipal Code have been satisfied, including but not limited to

evidence of compliance with the insurance and indemnification requirements of said chapter in a form acceptable to the City.

SECTION 3. Pursuant to Chapter 10.46 of the Pasadena Municipal Code, a non-exclusive police towing franchise ("Franchise") for a term of one year from the effective date of this ordinance is granted to:

The Franchise shall not become effective before the effective date of this ordinance and unless and until a written franchise agreement has been signed with the City and unless and until all the requirements set forth in Chapter 10.46 of the Pasadena Municipal Code have been satisfied, including but not limited to evidence of compliance with the insurance and indemnification requirements of said chapter in a form acceptable to the City.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after publication.


