SUBJECT: Purchase of Nine New 2000 Ford Crown Victoria Police Vehicles

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council: i) accept the bid dated April 5, 2000. submitted by Miracle Ford in response to specifications for the purchase of nine 2000 Ford Crown Victoria police vehicles, ii) reject all other bids and iii) authorize the Purchasing Administrator to issue a purchase order contract to Miracle Ford, in an amount not to exceed \$213,081.00.

BACKGROUND

Due to the nature of its operations, the Police Department requires specialized pursuit vehicles. The Building Systems and Fleet Management Division has determined that Ford is the only company manufacturing extra heavy-duty vehicles that meet the Department's requirements. The lifecycle of police vehicles is approximately three years. The proposed purchase will replace vehicles that have exceeded this lifecycle (*See Attachment).

On March 16, 2000, a Notice Inviting Bids was published in The Pasadena Journal. In addition, specifications were mailed to ten Ford dealers on the Purchasing Division's vendor list and the notification was posted on the City's web page. Two responses were received and opened in the City Clerk's office on April 5, 2000. The bid results are as follows:
