AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING
SECTION 6.12.010 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATED
TO DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE IN CITY PARKS

SECTION 1. Section 6.12.010 of the Pasadena Municipal Code is hereby amended to
read as follows:

“ 6.12.010 Running at large prohibited.

A. No person owning, having an interest in, harboring or having charge, care, control, custody or possession of any dog shall cause or permit such dog to be in or upon any public street, alley or other public place or in or upon any unenclosed lot or premises, unless such dog is securely confined by a strong cord, chain or leash, not exceeding 6 feet, securely and continuously held by a competent person owning, having an interest in, harboring or having charge, care, control, custody or possession of such dog, or unless such dog is confined within an automobile.

B. This section shall not apply to any city council designated off-leash dog park, to dogs participating in an exhibition, bench show or dog obedience training program in a city park and for which the city has issued a permit for said exhibition, bench show or

**training program. 'Dog obedience training program' shall mean
an organized plan or system of instruction consisting of interaction
between a dog and its trainer towards the goal of conditioning the dog
to obey the commands of the trainer."**

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect thirty days after its publication.


