**SUBJECT: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA SUSPENDING SECTIONS 9.36.150, 9.36.220 AND 9.36.230 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO LIMITATIONS ON AMPLIFIED SOUND AND NOISE SOURCES FOR AN EVENT, "THE WORLD SUPERCROSS SERIES" TO BE HELD AT THE ROSE BOWL**

**TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE:**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA SUSPENDING SECTIONS 9.36.150, 9.36.220 AND 9.36.230 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO LIMITATIONS ON HOURS OF OPERATION OF AMPLIFIED SOUND AND NOISE SOURCES FOR SPECIFIED HOURS AND AREAS ON NOVEMBER 19, 1999 AND NOVEMBER 20, 1999.

**PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE:**

This proposed ordinance is to provide an exemption from the Noise Ordinance for the proposed World Supercross Series to be held at the Rose Bowl Stadium for the practice day as to vehicle noise and general noise sources and on Event Day as to vehicle noise, general noise and amplified sound. The enactment of this proposed ordinance is needed for the event to take place.

This event was approved by the City Council at its meeting held August 16, 1999.

**REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED:**

The Noise Ordinance was enacted by ordinance and can only be suspended by an ordinance of the City Council.


FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

It is anticipated that the Rose Bowl Operating Company will receive a minimum License Fee of \$162,500 for the event or \$100,000 if more than 1/3 of an inch of rain falls on the event day, and that Speedvision Productions will assume all expenses for stadium preparation and reconstruction as outlined in its License Agreement with the RBOC.


ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT:

The Environmental Administrator has determined that the proposed suspension of the noise ordinance will be addressed as part of the Mitigated Negative Declaration and the Mitigation Monitoring Program, as, although the Motorcycles will be muffled according to the standards of the American Motorcycle Association, the acceptable level of 55 decibels will be exceeded during specific times during the Event and pre event preparations.



The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections 9.36.150 and 9.36.230 of the Pasadena Municipal Code are hereby suspended from the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on November 19, 1999 and Sections 9.36.150, 9.36.220 and 9.36.230 are suspended from the hours of 11:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. on November 20, 1999, for events at the Rose Bowl stadium for which a valid license agreement is in force and effect.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause this ordinance to be published in full text.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication.


